



## Welcome to Oriole Summer Camp 2022!

Below is some important information that you should know before your child begins camp. Please read this document carefully to ensure your child (and you!) have a great Camp experience.

**\*\*Please pass this information along to your caregiver or anyone else who may be dropping off your child.\*\***

**Daily Schedule:** we will be playing outside as much as we can this summer. Below is (a very loose) schedule of where the children will be, and when.

- 9:00-10:00 **All activity areas open (PLAYGROUND)**
- 10:00-10:15 **Indoors for washroom/hand washing**
- 10:15-10:45 **Snack (2 separate groups)**
- 10:45-12:00 **All activity areas open (PLAYGROUOND)**

### What to bring in a small backpack that your child can carry:

- Sunscreen (applied to child before drop-off)
- Hat (labelled)
- Change of clothes (or two!) (Please ensure all clothing is labelled)
- Extra wipes and diapers (if needed)
- Water bottle with a tight fitting lid (labelled)

Unfortunately, other belongings will not be permitted into the program such as: toys from home, soothers, baby bottles, etc.

**Absences:** If, *for any reason*, your child will be absent, please call Oriole at 416 960-1293 and leave a message indicating the reason for absence. (Due to COVID-19, teachers are required to follow up with any family who has a child who is absent.)

**\*\*Parents are caregivers are encouraged to wear a mask at drop-off and pick up\*\***

### Drop-off

- Camp begins at 9:00am and runs until 12:00pm. A complementary drop-off is offered beginning at 8:45am.
- A teacher will be outside of the gate from 8:45am-9:15am for screening purposes.
- Please wait on the grassy area, next to the numbered pylons for your family's turn for screening. While waiting, please observe social distancing guidelines.
- It is a good idea to pre-screen yourself and your child before leaving home. If you or your child (or any other member of your drop-off group) have a fever, or ANY cold-like symptoms, children will not be admitted into the program.
- Parents and caregivers are not allowed into the playground, or the building. Once your child 'passes' screening, the teacher will escort them into the playground/classrooms.
- In the event of **heat advisories** or **inclement weather**, camp will take place inside of Oriole Nursery School and the Community Hall (large gym.) Drop-off on these days will be just **inside of the wooden doors**. Please wait in the designated waiting area (on the grass) until a teacher indicates there is a space in the screening area.

### Pick-Up

- A teacher will be outside of the gate at 11:40am for dismissal
- Please wait in the screening area, by the pylons for your family's turn to pick-up your child.
- The teacher will bring your child, and their belongings outside of the playground (or, out of the wooden doors on rainy days)
- If you need to pick up your child before 11:40am, please call 416 960-1293 to inform a teacher, and wait on the grassy area by the pylons. Please do not enter the building.
- ✓ Please ensure your child is wearing **sunscreen** at drop off as most of the programming takes place outdoors.
- ✓ Please ensure that your child has gone to the **washroom** or their **diaper has been changed** before drop-off. (All facilities are currently closed to parents and caregivers.)
- ✓ Your child is free to wear the **footwear** of their choice, however, our playground is covered in sand. Closed toe shoes are recommended.
- ✓ **Snack** will be provided by the camp daily. Please do not send food with your child
